



## Winter Figure Skating Program 2017 - 2018

**PreCan and CanSkate Program:** Lessons are given in a group format and led by a NCCP certified professional coach. Coaches are supported by trained Program Assistants.

**Power Skating:** Ages 6-10. Skaters will be in full hockey equipment, and must be able to skate forwards, backwards and stop on a signal.

**Bronze Program:** includes one dance group, one skill group and group stroking per week

**Silver Program:** includes group stroking twice a week

**Gold Program:** includes group stroking twice a week

**Skate Canada Membership includes:**

1. An accident insurance benefit at a substantially lower cost to the members than that available in other sports .

**Skate Ontario Lottery book:**

## STARSKATE MEMBERS!

### Club Commitment Policy

Our club is a non profit organization run by volunteers. Being a part of the OFSC means volunteering and participating in our club fundraisers. New this year, our club has incorporated a new “**Club Commitment Policy.**” There are 3 aspects to this new policy. All StarSkaters will be expected to participate in two club fundraisers, and mandatory music playing throughout the year. If you are unable to attend an event or unable to make it to your scheduled music time, you will need to find someone to fill your spot. By doing this you have covered your responsibility. If you do not participate in the 3 commitments, a fee of \$360.00 will be charged to you by March 1st (music, bingo, not signing up for tag day) or following our Tag Day in April/May (not showing up to your scheduled time on tag day). Failure to pay this fee will result in not being able to sign up for the upcoming season or be eligible to try tests during test day. Each skater needs to sign up for one Bingo a year (parents, guardian etc. will have to fill this responsibility) and a time slot during our tag day. There will be no credits given for participating in either of these fundraisers. Bingo credits will be given if you volunteer for more than one bingo.

Playing music is a very important part of our StarSkate program. Families will be added to the music schedule which can be found on our website. You are responsible to play music during your scheduled time; find someone to play the music for you or switch times with another family if you can not make the scheduled date.

### Group Freeskate Lessons

We are including group freeskate lessons one day a week during the winter season for Bronze and Silver sessions. Skaters will have an opportunity to work with each of our coaches that are on the session. Skaters will be grouped according to skill level and rotate amongst our highly trained coaches. This is a great opportunity for skaters to not only work with their coach, but learn from other coaches as well. Skaters will be charged a fee for the semi-private lessons they will be receiving. However, this fee will be split by the number of skaters that are in the group which means skaters will, in some cases, be receiving more lessons for less cost. It is the parent's responsibility to pay each coach. If your child chooses to skate on the day group freeskate is taking place (Monday for Silver and Wednesday for Bronze), your child will be expected to participate in all the lessons and will be charged accordingly.
